## IMMIGRATION LAW

## PHYSICIAN IMMIGRATION

Because immigrant doctors play such a critical role in the U.S. healthcare system (over 25% of all doctors in the U.S. are foreign-born), special immigration laws apply to them. These special laws include the two year home-residency requirement for foreign-born physicians coming to the U.S. for graduate medical education, and the five year national interest waiver for clinical physicians.
